All I can say is if your continually spinning something in your script is telling you to do it.



if you get stuck in a spin at 30FPS you might get a MAX of 2 rotations before ISXWoW will END face.

If your still spinning it's because your still calling face over and over and the ISXWoW built in spinfix isn't going to stop you from spinning if your telling it that's what you want to do ☺


If your stuck in a spin, try typing "face -stop" in the IS console and see if it ends it. Pausing your bot should also allow it to autostop as well as it shouldn't be continuing to call face anymore.


FYI, I use smart camera follow on all my systems with almost 0 spinning and NEVER getting stuck in a spin.
